Scholarship Overview

In honor of CAI Business Partner and CAI-CLAC Delegate Duncan McPherson's longstanding commitment to California legislation, CAI-CLAC is providing financial support for a Homeowner Leader or Community Manager to attend the 2019 CAI-CLAC Legislative Day at the Capitol held on Monday, April 8 and Tuesday, April 9, 2019 in Sacramento. The scholarship winner will receive paid registration for all 2019 CAI-CLAC Legislative Day at the Capitol events (CAI-California North Sunday evening Corks 4 CLAC event not included) the Meet the Delegates Reception, not to exceed \$750 for travel and lodging expenses (if required) to be reimbursed to the scholarship recipient within 30-days of submission (to CAI-CLAC) of all receipts related to the conference. Any portion of the \$750 not used in connection with the Day at the Capital may be used to cover registration, travel and lodging for the 2019 CAI Legal Forum: California Communities and CAI-CLAC Benefit Fundraiser Event, held the night before.

Requirements

- Applicant must be a CAI member in good standing.
- Applicant must be currently serving as a Homeowner Leader in his or her community association or working as a Community Manager.
- The scholarship must be used for the 2019 CAI-CLAC Legislative Day at the Capitol.
- Funds may be used only for documented, travel, lodging and meals directly related to the 2019 CAI-CLAC Legislative Day at the Capitol, and the scholarship winner must stay at the conference hotel. (Unused funds may be used for registration, travel and lodging for the 2019 CAI Legal Forum: California Communities and CAI-CLAC Benefit Fundraiser Event held the night before.)
- In both cases, the scholarship winner must attend the full conference.
- The scholarship winner must provide a written summary/report of his or her experiences at the Day at the Capitol within two weeks of the experience, to be used for a future CAI-CLAC blog.
- Only one scholarship per individual (lifetime) will be awarded.
- Preference will be given to first-time attendees of the 2019 CAI-CLAC Legislative Day at the Capitol.
